

A 70 inch television, sound bar, and other audio/video equipment are now available for public use in the library's **Community Room**, increasing its value as a meeting space for, as examples, PowerPoint presentations, televised sports events, private screenings, and public movie matinees. A new Cisco Meraki access point and input injector secures and powers a consistent, high speed Wi-Fi connection required for streaming.

Policy Governing Use of Depauville Free Library's Large-Screen Television

Depauville Free Library's large-screen television is intended to be used for educational, informational, and recreational purposes serving our community.

Broadcast/cable channels or recorded material may be displayed as part of library-sponsored programs or by request. Priority is given to educational-related and instructional use. The library reserves the right to deny any request.

Requests to display recorded material (DVDs, VHS recordings, Blu-Ray discs) or to stream a video conference require approval by the Library Director or designee and proof of compliance with copyright restrictions. Individual viewing of library materials does not require copyright clearance.

The equipment is not used to record programming.
